- Psalms 92:1-15. Praise, singing, music, worship on S
- Isa. 1:2-20(13, 14). S and new moons
- (13) Isa. 56:1-8. Keep S, please God, His covenant
- (14) Isa. 58:1-14. S reform
- (15) Isa. 66:22, 23. S new earth
- (16) Jer. 17:19-27. Do not bear burdens on S. Keep holy. God will burn Jerusalem is S not kept holy
- Lam. 2:6, 7. S and festivals—caused to forget
- (17) Eze. 20:1-49(12-21). S a sign between God and His people. But they profane S. Israel left in wilderness because profaned S
