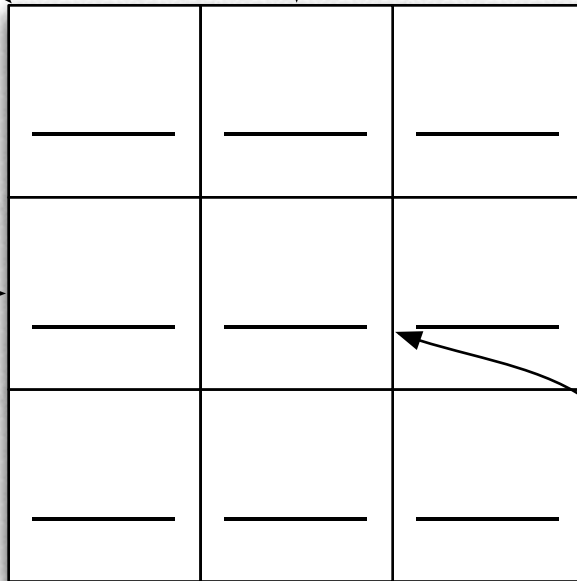

The imagination is visually oriented

The imagination manifests itself with reference to a “canvas” in 2D or 3D space, a TV or computer screen, the mind, and so forth

The source material used by the imagination is derived from the real world



What occurs is known to be and considered to be unreal by the god of the imaginary castle

The world of the imaginary castle is private, hidden from others

Output is not to the real world but to the imaginary castle; it is solely centered around the indulgence of self

Imaginary events are controlled and scripted by the god of the castle

Is populated only by people as imagined by the god of the castle

The imaginary world is not bounded by physical laws, and not restricted by real world situations or the operation of providence in the real world
